Use of cookies

We and our partners use cookies on our website. Necessary cookies are used to make the website work. What are Cookies?

What are remote resources?

First time visit to our site

Re-visiting our site

What are first and third party cookies?

The same cookie can be either 'first-party cookie' or 'third-party cookie' depending on which site you visit. If you request to see a website (A), and that website uses content (code, maps, blog posts, videos) directly from another website (B), then your request to see the website (A) will also trigger a request to the other website (B) and attach and send the associated cookies to the other website (B). The other website (B) may on website (A) show to you content delivered directly from website (B), and also use other functionalities such as payments, measure website traffic etc.

How can you control Cookies?

Control cookies via your browser

You can enable or disable cookies, as well as delete your browsing history (including cookies) from your browser. Please refer to the options and instructions provided by your browser. If you accept third-party cookies, you can only delete them from your browser's options menu.
